This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.147 dated 04.07.2017 registered under Sections 406, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties and a petition bearing **CRM-M No.54765 of 2018** for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise has been filed, which is fixed for hearing on 12.04.2019.

The factum of compromise has also been affirmed by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant.

Since a compromise has been arrived at between the parties and a petition for quashing of FIR is pending after recording the statements of the parties, wherein, the factum of compromise has been affirmed, the present petition is allowed and petitioner, namely, Ashok Kumar is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
