HARI PAL VERMA, J.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.02 dated 04.01.2019 (Annexure P-7) under Section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 and Section 498-A IPC registered at Police Station PS Women, Amritsar along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is an old man of about 73 years of age and has to travel all the way from Faridabad to Amritsar which is situated at quite a distance.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Perusal of the paper book shows that the marriage of Ashish Magu, who is son of the petitioner, was solemnized with Purnima Sabikhi daughter of respondent No.2-complainant on 29.05.2013. Respondent No.2-

complainant is mother of Purnima Sabikhi and is a resident of Amritsar. The son of petitioner is residing in U.K. and the FIR in question was registered only on 04.01.2019. Thus, without giving an opportunity to the police to look into the FIR, the petitioner has straightway rushed to this Court for quashing of the FIR. Therefore, this Court finds that interference at this stage is not warranted when the matter is already under investigation.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed at this stage being pre-mature.
