In my opinion, in case the averment that the petitioner has never previously misused the concession of bail is correct then this one lapse can be condoned. In the circumstances, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on the date fixed (which is stated to be 28.01.2019) and in case the statement that he has never misused the concession of bail previously is correct the Court would release him on bail to its satisfaction.

In this view of the matter, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the prayer of the petitioner.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
