Petitioner is seeking quashing of the order dated 24.12.2018/02.01.2019 (Annexure P-5), whereby petitioner has been transferred from the office of District Education Officer, Sonipat to the office of Block Education Officer, Ganaur, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to the letter dated 02.01.2019 (Annexure P-7) written by the District Education Officer, Sonipat to the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, whereby it has been stated that the petitioner had joined in the office of DEO, Sonipat on 20.07.2017 and he was doing satisfactory work, therefore, his transfer be cancelled. It has been highlighted in this letter that Jashvir Singh-petitioner is doing the work of MIS and HRMS at district level in respect of whole of the district Sonipat and there is no employee, who can look after the work of MIS and HRMS. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on account of not uploading the information on MIS portal, some contradictory orders are being passed.

on behalf of respondent No.4-Yogender Kumar and states that he has already taken the charge.

Keeping in view the information that there is no other employee, who can do the work of MIS and HRMS in the office of DEO, Sonipat, the present petition is disposed of by giving direction to respondent No.2-Director General, Secondary Education, Haryana to look into the letter dated 02.01.2019 (Annexure P-7) written by the District Education Officer in accordance with law, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner has not been relieved, he shall continue to work on the said post and operation of the impugned order dated 24.12.2018, indorsed on 02.01.2019 (Annexure P-5), shall remain stayed qua the present petitioner.
