This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.269 dated 31.12.2018 registered under Sections 379-B/506/34 IPC at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh has accepted the factum of compromise between the parties.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of

the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the

Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438
(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on 11.02.2019 and on any other date as and when his presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
