[1] On 03.07.2018 after arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner had confined the relief claimed in the revision petition only to grant of some time to vacate the premises, whereupon notice of motion was issued for 11.07.2018. The case was adjourned from time to time and now is listed for hearing on 18.03.2019.

[2] Application has been moved by the applicant/respondent for preponement of CR No.4052 of 2018. Notice of the application was issued to the counsel for the non-applicant/petitioner for today.

[3] Mr. Atul Bhatia, Advocate for the non-applicant/petitioner has put in appearance.

[4] Heard learned counsel for the parties.

[5] For the reasons as are mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Date of hearing is preponed from 18.03.2019 to today. Main case is taken on board.

CR No.4052 of 2018 (O&M)

[6] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that although the petitioner has vacated the premises in question and shifted to an alternative residence, yet some time be granted to the petitioner to hand-over the possession of the same to the respondent on account of the petitioner's daughter having died on 23.01.2019.

[7] Although, no case is made out for grant of further time to hand-over the possession of the premises in question to the respondent, yet taking into account the aforementioned aspect of the matter, the petitioner is granted two weeks' time to hand-over the vacant possession of the premises in question to the respondent by 18.02.2019.

[8] Revision petition is disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
