The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 17.12.2018, vide which, the writ petition was disposed of with a direction to the committee to look into the grievance of the petitioners and in case, the millers are found eligible for allocation, the District Administration shall take steps forthwith for shifting the paddy and in case, the committee rejects the case of the petitioners, a speaking order shall be passed, which the petitioners will be at liberty to challenge.

Short reply by way of affidavit of M.P. Singh, District Manager, Punjab State Warehousing Corporation District Ludhiana dated 21.2.2019 filed in Court is taken on record.

Admittedly, the respondents have since decided the case of the petitioners and rejected the same by passing a speaking order dated 21.2.2019. The said order has been handed over to learned counsel for the

petitioners.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

The petitioners are at liberty to challenge the order dated 21.2.2019 in accordance with law.
