The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.46 dated 19.06.2018, under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC and Sections 411, 489, 201 and 120-B IPC and Section 25/54/59-A of the Arms Act, 1959 (amended later on), registered at Police Station GRP Patiala, District Patiala.

On 19.03.2019 when the matter had come up for hearing, learned State counsel has submitted before the coordinate Bench of this Court that the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 01.12.2018. Learned counsel for the petitioner had sought time to seek instructions.

The matter has been called twice but no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. In any event, as the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender, he would not be entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

The petition stands dismissed.
