Petitioner Pushpa Rani has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.91 dated 09.10.2013, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar (Rural), under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the allegation against the present petitioner is that she impersonated herself as Surjit Kaur and executed the sale deed.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody since 25.06.2018. She is not required for any investigation or

interrogation purposes as she is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. The offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class. No useful purpose will be served by keeping her in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and the custody period of the petitioner; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
