This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing detainee Sandeep Kaur from the illegal custody of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Notice of motion was issued and SHO concerned was directed to visit the address of private respondent Nos.4 to 7 to find out whether detainee Sandeep Kaur has been detained illegally against her wish or is residing there with her own wish. If he finds that she has been detained illegally against her wish by the private respondents then she be produced in the Court.

Today alleged detainee Sandeep Kaur has been produced in the Court by the SHO concerned. On enquiry by this Court, she states that she is aged about 23 years. She has performed marriage with petitioner Gurtej Singh. She also states that now she is residing in her in-laws house with her husband-Gurtej Singh. She further states that she wants to go with petitioner Gurtej Singh from the Court today itself as per her own consent.

In view of the statement made by detainee-Sandeep Kaur, the

instant petition stands allowed.
