RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):

Through this petition, the petitioner has sought for a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents/State to consider the parole case of the petitioner and to release him for a period of six weeks to enable him to meet his family members.

Learned State counsel submits that as per the custody certificate on record, the petitioner has undergone the actual sentence for a period of only 2 years, 03 months and 05 days up to 06.09.2019 out of the rigorous imprisonment of 10 years under Sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

No ground for parole is made out keeping in view the period of sentence undergone by the petitioner.

Dismissed.
