[1] A compromise is stated to have been arrived at amongst the parties on the basis of which vide order dated 11.03.2019, parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court for producing the written compromise dated 03.11.2018 as well as for recording their statements in view thereof.

[2] Pursuant thereto, report has been submitted by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana dated 05.04.2019 that after going through the statements of the parties so recorded, the learned Judicial Magistrate was of the considered view that the compromise between the parties was valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence. Copy of the report is taken on record. Learned counsel pray for directions to the learned trial Court to pass decree in terms of the compromise.

[3] In view of the position as noted above, the revision petition is disposed of by directing the parties to put in appearance before the learned trial Court on 01.05.2019 for filing compromise as well as report of the learned trial Court dated 05.04.2019 and for the learned trial Court to pass decree in terms of the compromise.

[4] Revision petition is disposed of in the aforementioned terms.

[5] Since, the main case has been decided, all pending C.Ms. stand disposed of.
