This civil revision has been filed for setting aside the order dated 31.5.2014 passed by the District Judge, Rohtak, whereby the application of the petitioner for withdrawal of 50% of the amount of FDRs of her minor children, was dismissed.

The controversy arose from the award dated 2.4.2013 passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Rohtak.
