The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dalwara Singh, Police Station Women Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, submits that petitioners in consequence of order dated 21.01.2019 have joined the investigation besides the fact that parties have effected a settlement and has placed on record the photocopy of the statements made in divorce proceedings and nothing is to be recovered from them and does not oppose the grant of bail.

In light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 21.01.2019 is made

absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (challan).
Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioners shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
