On 23.08.2018, the following order had been passed:-

“Learned counsel for respondent no.1 very fairly submits that as a matter of fact the suit of the respondents-plaintiffs having been dismissed in default vide an order passed by the learned Civil Judge (Jr.Div.), Ajnala, on January 30, 2017, this petition would be rendered infructuous.

Whether or not any application for restoration is pending or has been decided would be need to look at and consequently, since counsel for the petitioner is not present, it being past 4 p.m., adjourned to 30.08.2018.

Thereafter, on a joint request of the parties made on 30.08.2018, the matter had been adjourned, with the turn of the case not having come up, thereafter.
