Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.229 dated 05.10.2018 under Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 21.01.2019: -

*“.....Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and his name is figured in the disclosure statement of co-accused Sudesh Kumar @ Babbu, from whom a country-made pistol was recovered. It is further submitted that even in the disclosure statement, it is stated that co-accused has purchased the said weapon from the petitioner, whereas the petitioner is not involved in such activity.....”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Parshottam Lal, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.01.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
