Admittedly, the parties have amicably resolved their dispute through a written compromise dated 22.11.2018 (Annexure R-1).

In view of the said compromise, learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from the respondent, who is present in Court, undertakes to withdraw his application filed by him before the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Chandigarh (for short – the Executing Court) seeking therein execution of the decree dated 23.08.2017 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chandigarh (for short – the Trial Court) in his favour. Learned counsel for the respondent further submits that subject to the petitioner abiding by the terms of the compromise dated 22.11.2018 (Annexure R-1), the respondent gives up all his rights conferred upon him through the afore-referred decree of the Trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner admits to the compromise

between the parties and has no objection if the aforesaid prayer made by the respondent is accepted.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

It is clarified that in case either party backs out of the aforesaid compromise the other party shall be at liberty to renew the litigation which they would have withdrawn in view of the said compromise.
