It is alleged on behalf of the petitioner that on account of political rivalry, he is being harassed by the SHO of Police Station, Sadar Samana. The police has also ransacked his house and taken away valuable articles. A detailed representation dated 15.1.2019 (Annexure P-1) has been submitted but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. Luvinder Sofat, learned AAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Let five copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day. Considering the nature of order being passed, no notice is required to be issued to respondents No.5 and 6.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to objectively consider the representation dated 15.1.2019 (Annexure P-1) and to take appropriate action thereupon, in case found necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
