Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in the FIR No.129 dated 10.12.2018, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City-2, Mansa, District Mansa.

Contentends that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also acknowledged the above factual position.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from police official present in Court to assist him, has apprised the Court that in view of the compromise effected between the parties, custodial interrogation of

the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above agreed stand taken by both sides, the present petition is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous. In case, occasion so arises, petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
