Petitioner Sagar has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.415 dated 20.11.2018, registered at Police Station Ambala City, District Amabala, under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, only 20 grams of heroin has been recovered from the present petitioner, which falls in non-commercial quantity.

The petitioner has been in custody since 20.11.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial

custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹35,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
