By way of moving the present revision petition, the revisionist has challenged the orders dated 18.10.2018 as well as 14.12.2018, passed by Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) Sohna, vide which, the application filed by plaintiffs/respondents Nagender Singh and Yogender Singh for appointment of Local Commissioner had been allowed, whereas, application filed by the petitioner/defendant No.4 had been dismissed.

The Local Commissioner has already visited the spot and submitted his report. If so aggrieved, the petitioner can file objections against the said report and seek its setting aside by the trial Court. There is no illegality or infirmity in the impugned orders, much less apparent on the face of such orders, which might have called for

interference by this Court by exercising revisional jurisdiction. There being no merit in the revision petition, the same stands dismissed.
