Petitioner is stated to be 92 years of age. It is pleaded that on 25.7.2018 he had filed an application/petition under Section 22 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 seeking eviction of respondents no.3 and 4 herein, who happen to be his daughter and son-in-law respectively from the premises in question i.e. House No. 252, Sector 7, Panchkula.

The short grievance raised in the instant petition is that the application filed by the petitioner is not being decided and the matter is lingering on before respondent no.2. Counsel submits that after filing of the application under the 2007 Act even a report had been sought from the S.D.M., Panchkula and the same has also since been received. Counsel prays for issuance of directions to respondent no.2 to decide the petition/application filed by the petitioner within a stipulated time frame.

In view of such limited relief sought, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition without even issuing notice to the respondents so as to avoid any further and unnecessary delay.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to proceed further in the matter and to take a final decision on the

application/petition filed by the petitioner under the 2007 Act in accordance with law and to pass final order within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is, however, clarified that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case.

Disposed of.
