The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.206 dated 11.11.2018, registered under Sections 354, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar (P-1).

It is a case of cross-version and it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that both the parties have suffered injuries.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 21.01.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
