GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of direction to official respondents to proceed against accused in respect of FIR No.99 dated 05.07.2017 under Sections 336, 506, 511, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar (Rural).
2. Learned counsel has submitted that private respondents used to sit in front of his shop and consume liquor and used to block the passage which used to affect his business and upon the petitioner and others having objected to the same, the petitioner was given beatings and the accused fired at the counter of the shop and damaged the same with the help of '*Datar*'.

3. Learned counsel has submitted that although FIR No.99 dated 05.07.2017 under Sections 336, 506, 511, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar (Rural) was lodged in respect of the incident in question, but Police instead of taking action against the accused has unnecessarily been calling the petitioner time and again who is made to sit in the Police Station for 2/3 hours every time.
4. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-2) expeditiously and to take necessary steps for conclusion of investigation in respect of FIR in question.
5. Further, in case, the petitioner is required to be associated with any inquiry or investigation or some information is to be elicited from him, then a written advance notice in terms of Section 160 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 be served upon him.
6. A copy of this order along with copy of the representation (Annexure P-1) be sent to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously, preferably within a period of '3 months' from today.
