Through this petition, the petitioner has sought bail pending trial in case FIR No.78 dated 26.08.2018 registered under Sections 382 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 to which offence under Sections 392 of IPC and 25 of Arms Act 1959 were added later on at Police Station Bakshiwala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not involved in the present case. The case has been concocted against him. It is further contended by the counsel that in the present FIR, there is no recovery from the petitioner as such. The petitioner is in custody since 03.09.2018. Charges have also been framed in this case. The co-accused with similar allegations have already been released on bail by this Court.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the motorcycle, which was snatched from the complainant, have subsequently been recovered in an another incident, where five persons including the present petitioner were arrested from the spot and that motorcycle which is snatched in the incident involved in the present case; was also found with

those five persons including the present petitioner.

In response thereto, counsel for the petitioner submits that in that another case, the petitioner has already been released on bail by the trial Court.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, but without expressing any further opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
