Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.124 dated 07.06.2018, under Sections 323/324/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326 added lateron) registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, district Ferozepur.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 21.01.2019:-

*In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join
the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the
event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him
to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his
furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his
satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by
all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)*

Cr.P.C.”

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from Investigating Officer has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 21.01.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
