The petitioner seeks quashing of letter dated 04.08.2018 (Annexure P-13), vide which, the investigation of FIR No.361 dated 29.07.2018 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 409, 471 & 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala has been transferred to State Crime Branch, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the accused is sister of the retired DGP, therefore, the police is not taking any action in the matter.

I am of the view that the above said contention is not acceptable. The Director General of Police, Haryana has taken out the investigation from the local police and transferred it to Special Agency i.e. State Crime Branch, Haryana for investigation. State Crime Branch, Haryana is yet to investigate the case and present the final report. Therefore, there is no ground to interfere in the letter of DGP, Haryana dated 04.08.2018

(Annexure P-13) for transferring the investigation to State Crime Branch, Haryana.

Accordingly petition is dismissed.

Respondents are also directed to ensure that no physical harm is caused to the petitioner on account of lodging of the FIR.
