The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail because vide order dated 22.11.2018, his regular bail has been cancelled.

The petitioner is accused in an FIR registered under various provisions of law including the NDPS Act, 1985. It appears that he was on regular bail but the same was cancelled and non-bailable warrants of arrest were issued vide order dated 27.11.2018 because he has not put in appearance on the said date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a wrong date had been noted by the counsel of the petitioner. The petitioner has all along appeared before the trial Court without any lapse and, thus, a lenient view may be taken.

The petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 28.1.2019 and seek regular bail. In case, such an application is filed, the trial Court shall allow the same, subject to its satisfaction.
