In compliance of the order dated 21.1.2019, SHO, Police Station Tauru, Nuh, District Mewat, along with lady Constable Anita, has produced the detenue Rashida daughter of the petitioner. In pursuance to order passed in CRM-M-64775 of 2018 filed by Rashida and another, a meeting was arranged and the case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre for recording her statement. She has stated that she performed marriage of her own free will and did not want to go back with her parents and she has given this statement without any threat or coercion.

A perusal of the order dated 31.12.2018 passed in CRM-M-64975 of 2018 shows that Superintendent of Police, Mewat had been directed to look into the grievances of the petitioners, therein and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the SHO, states that both of them are kept in the safe house.

As the detenue-Rashida, has made statement that she does not want to go with her parents, the present petition is rendered infructuous and the same is dismissed as such.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to take legal action, against respondent No.4, in accordance with law, if so advised.
