Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.211 dated 23.12.2018, registered under Section 61, 1, 14 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Sri Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dharam Pal, has stated that petitioner has already joined the investigation; recovery has already been effected and he is no more required for further custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 21.01.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
