Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.11 dated 25.02.2017 under Sections 457, 380, 447, 511 IPC, registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that admittedly, the petitioner is owner of the shop in dispute and the civil litigation is pending between the parties. It is further submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is ready to furnish a security of Rs.2.00 lacs with the trial Court subject to final outcome of the case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Anwar Masih and

assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has however submitted that the recovery of the stolen articles is yet to be effected.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.01.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and on furnishing security of Rs.2.00 lacs.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
