DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for respondents No. 3 and 4 submits that since the main suit has been withdrawn by the petitioner the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the above fact. However, he states that there are certain observations in the impugned order 30.05.2018, passed by the Additional District Judge, Ludhiana (for short, the Appellate Court), which will prejudice the petitioner.

The apprehension expressed by learned counsel for the petitioner is misconceived as in the aforesaid order itself the Appellate Court has observed that the order shall have no effect on the merits of the main suit.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
