This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.17 dated 08.02.2018 registered under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner would surrender and move an application for regular bail and a direction be issued to the court to decide his bail application expeditiously.

Deputy Advocate General, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh states that she has no objection to this course of action.

In the circumstances, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the Court on or before 11.02.2019 and move an application for regular bail, it shall be decided expeditiously but in any case by 14.02.2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
