The present writ petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* to direct the respondents to allow the claim of the petitioner for appointment on compassionate ground.

2.) Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is eligible and qualified to be appointed in any Class-IV job of respondent No.1-Bank i.e. Punjab and Sind Bank. He further states that petitioner's mother was working as a Class-IV employee and died in harness on 11.04.2008. Petitioner has been running from pillar to post and has also submitted representations (Annexures P-2 to P-5) from time to time but to no avail.

3.) The petitioner also caused issuance of a legal note through his counsel dated 22.10.2018 (Annexure P-6). Even that has not been adverted by the respondents till date.

4.) Keeping in view the nature of order being passed, no formal issuance of notice is warranted as no further pleadings or proceedings are required in this case. The respondents are directed to pass speaking order, in accordance with law keeping in view the contentions raised by the petitioner in his representations (Annexures P-2 to P-5) as also legal notice dated 22.10.2018 (Annexure P-6), within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

5.) Disposed of accordingly.
