Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C.  
for quashing of FIR No.6 dated 13.1.2018, under Section 306 IPC,  
registered at Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur.

On 29.4.2019, following order was passed by this Court :-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that admittedly the deceased, namely, Vishal son of Nirmal Kaur returned to India three months back before committing the suicide. According to him, the statement of deceased was recorded on 10.01.2018 (Annexure P-3) wherein it was clearly stated by Vishal that he consumed poison with his own will. He has not attributed any allegation regarding the abetment against anyone much less against petitioner No.1-Mandeep Kaur or her brother and aunt (petitioner Nos.2 and 3). According to*

*him, no case for abetment to suicide punishable under Section 306 IPC is made out. However, the Police has proceeded to submit final report before the Court for the said offence.*

*Let the final report be produced before this Court on the next date of hearing.*

*Adjourned to 30.05.2019.*

*In the meantime, charges be not framed against the petitioners.”*

It is apprised by learned State counsel that after completion of investigation, final report stands submitted before the trial Court on 25.3.2019. However, it is not disputed that the victim Vishal had himself got recorded his statement on 10.1.2018 (Annexure P-3) whereby it was stated that the poison was consumed by him voluntarily with his own will.

Since the final report is not before this Court, therefore, the present petition is disposed off with liberty to the petitioners to raise all these issues before the trial Court at the stage of framing of charges and it is expected that the trial Court shall consider all the relevant issues raised by the petitioners at that stage.
