[1]. After hearing this revision petition for some time, it appears that the Surveyor of the petitioner-Company had assessed the claim of respondent No.2 at Rs.3601/- as against total claim of Rs.41,219/-. The stand taken by the petitioner-Company was that original bills were not received over and above the aforesaid amount of Rs.3601/-.

[2]. On 12.09.2018, during course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner showed readiness on the part of the petitioner-Company, even to consider remaining bills in the sum

of Rs.37,618/- in case original of the bills are submitted to the petitioner-Company.

[3]. In view of aforesaid willingness on behalf of the petitioner, respondent No.2 was obligated to submit original bills in the sum of Rs.37,618/- to the petitioner-Company within two weeks from that day. Petitioner-Company was to consider the genuineness of the aforesaid bills within further period of two weeks thereafter.

[4]. Today, learned counsel for respondent No.2 submitted that the original bills are available in the judicial file and he shall make every endeavour to take the aforesaid bills in due course of law and shall submit the same with the petitioner-Company within a period of three weeks from today.

[5]. In view of above, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the original bills are submitted to the petitioner-Company, the petitioner-Company shall consider the same as per terms and conditions of the policy in accordance with law.
