SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

In compliance of the earlier order dated 08.05.2019, an affidavit on behalf of Ld. Counsel for the petitioner is filed today in the Court; Be kept on the record. A copy of the same has been supplied to the Counsel opposite.

2. In the affidavit, the petitioner has undertaken to vacate the demised premises by 8th March, 2020 and also to pay occupational charges at the rate of Rs.1000/- per month after paying the outstanding balance for the months of May and June, 2019.

3. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that starting from the month of June itself, the outstanding as well as current occupational charges will be paid to the respondent regularly by the 7th day of each calendar month.

4. In view of the aforesaid undertaking and submission, the revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn with a direction upon the respondent not to resort to any coercive measures against the petitioner till 8th March, 2020. However, this order shall not provide any protection to the petitioner, in case he defaults in making payment of the occupational charges in any given month by the 7th day of that particular month.
