Petitioner seeks a Mandamus for directing the respondents to pay a compensation amount of Rs.20 lakhs on account of death of his son Babaldeep Singh and which was stated to have been caused on account of accident caused by stray animals.

The petition raises a question of fact as to whether the death of the son of petitioner had actually been caused in an accident involving the stray animals. Towards determination of such issue, evidence may have to be led.

At this stage, counsel prays for withdrawal of the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail of his civil remedies as may be available in accordance with law.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
