MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.58 dated 08.02.2018 registered under Sections 420, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Sadar, District Fatehabad (Haryana).

On 22.01.2019, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR pertains to the alleged advancement of finance facility to one Vikram, wherein Pawan stood his guarantor. It is pointed out that the petitioner has no role in the entire transaction and his name figures in the inquiry only for the reason that he misled the guarantor namely Pawan, on the basis of which FIR in question was registered. It is contended that guarantor had himself signed all the documents relating to the transaction of loan.

Notice of motion for 26.03.2019.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join the

investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 22.01.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kapil submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 22.01.2019, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
