This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.153 dated 10.07.2018 under Sections 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Division No.6, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

On 25.01.2019, the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner was recorded before this Court, wherein willingness of the petitioner to pay the amount in question was shown. On 08.03.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.2 filed in

Court today is taken on record. Office to tag the same at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to bring demand draft for a sum of Rs.10.00 lakh in the name of respondent No.2 adding interest @ 12% per annum from the date on which the said amount was taken, failing which this petition shall be dismissed for want of prosecution.

Adjourned to 2.4.2019 for consideration.”

Thereafter, the matter is being adjourned only for compliance of the order dated 08.03.2019. For the last two dates, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner which reflects complete lack of interest. Apart from it, considering the conduct of the petitioner, this Court does not find any reason to further adjourn the case.

Petition is dismissed.
