This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take legal action against respondent No.4 and other guilty director of Nature Heights Infra Ltd. in accordance with law, for committing fraud with the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners states that in this connection the petitioners have also moved a representation dated 04.09.2018 (Annexure P-4) and at this stage they would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 – SSP, Hoshiarpur to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law within a period of two

weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
