GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioners – Gurpreet Kaur and Karmveer Singh have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents No.4 to 7, who are parents, brother and relative of petitioner No.1. Petitioner No.1 has annexed copy of her AADHAR Card to the effect that she is aged 20 years, while petitioner No.2 is less than marriageable aged of 21 years.
2. The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.
3. Petitioner No.2-Karmveer Singh is stated to be less than 21 years of age.

4. The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib to look into the representation (Annexure P-4) made by petitioners, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any serious apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.
5. It is, however, made clear that this order shall not be taken to be an expression as regards validity of the alleged marriage of the parties and shall not be deemed to confer any immunity upon petitioners from any action warranted under law for having married before the marriageable age.
