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**AMIT RAWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The short point involved in the present revision petition is whether the petitioner-defendant No.2 can be permitted to challenge the order passed in an application under Order 33 Rules 1 & 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure based upon the report of the Collector, granting the permission to pursue the suit for fixation of maintenance, as indigent person. The answer would be 'No'.

No material was placed on record either before the Court below allowing the application or before this Court to belie the report of the Collector. The trial Court, in my view, has rightly allowed the application. No ground is made out for interference. Resultantly, the present revision petition is dismissed.
