In compliance of order dated 11.03.2019 passed by this Court, affidavit of Charanjit Singh, Executive Engineer, Majitha Division U.B.D.C., Amritsar has been filed wherein it has been disclosed that the execution filed by the decree holders has already been dismissed as withdrawn being fully satisfied by the respondents after making statement by Gopal Singh on 06.01.2016.

An amount of Rs.4,31,595/- was received by the decree holders vide draft No.761252 dated 04.01.2016 drawn on Punjab National Bank, Branch Amritsar Cantt, Amritsar vide order dated 06.01.2016 passed by the Executing Court. The aforesaid order has also been attached along with the affidavit.

Since this revision petition has been filed by the State along with an application for condonation of delay of 1608 days in filing the revision and the execution has already been withdrawn by the decree holders, therefore, at this stage no further action is required to be done in the present revision petition and the same is disposed of as such. However, liberty is granted to the parties to get it revived in case statement of fact borne on record is found to be otherwise.

In case of revival of the petition, petitioner would be obligated to make out sufficient grounds for condonation of delay first and then to proceed with the revision petition in accordance with law.
