Petitioner-Harinderjit Singh has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* for releasing detainee-Gurjant Singh alongwith truck bearing No.PB-11-CF-8748, who has been illegally detained by respondents No.3 to 5.

Vide order dated 21.01.2019 passed by this Court, Warrant Officer was appointed and he was directed to visit the place where the detainee alongwith truck is alleged to be detained illegally and get him released, if he is found to be in illegal custody.

In compliance of the order dated 21.01.2019, the Warrant Officer has submitted his report.

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I have perused the report of Warrant Officer.

In his report, the Warrant Officer has reported that the detainee was not found in the Police Station Sanaur at the time of his visit. However, a truck was stated to be parked in the premises of rice sheller. On the asking of Warrant Officer, a person stated that two persons had left the truck there and later on, it was taken by the petitioner. On the asking of Warrant Officer, the petitioner stated that he does not want to visit any other place in search of Gurjant Singh.

In view of the report submitted by the Warrant Officer, no further action is required in this petition.

Disposed of.

However, the proceedings conducted by the Warrant Officer regarding truck in question, can be seen independently by the competent authorities and this order, in no way, relates to the disputed truck.
