Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.336 dated 19.12.2018 under Sections 66-E and 67-A of the Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008 and Section 509 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 13.03.2019 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balkar Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 13.03.2019 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
