This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.699 dated 29.10.2018 registered under Sections 307/34 IPC, 1860 and 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner would surrender and move an application for regular bail and a direction be issued to the court to decide his bail application expeditiously. I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the court on or before

02.02.2019 and move an application for regular bail, it shall be decided expeditiously but in any case by 04.02.2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
