Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.186 dated 15.09.2018 under Sections 307, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 188, 202, 212 IPC and Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Ismailabad, Distirct Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner-Pawan Shukla has been falsely implicated in the case on the basis of statement of co-accused from whom the alleged recovery was effected. The petitioner is in custody since 16.11.2018 and decision of the case still to take some more time, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel while opposing the bail application contended that the petitioner is involved along with co-accused in manufacturing the illicit liquor and he does not deserve the concession of

Having considered the submission made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that petitioner-Pawan Kumar is in custody since 16.11.2018; rather no recovery was effected from the present petitioner in this case and he was arrested on the basis of statement of co-accused; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner-Pawan Kumar is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.

However, it is made clear that the observation made above may not be construed as expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
