It comes out that petitioner has not approached the Superintendent of District Jail, Kaithal rather he has not made him the party but Deputy Superintendent of District Jail, Kaithal has been made party.

In such circumstances, petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to move a representation before the Superintendent of District Jail, Kaithal for emergency parole on the grounds stated in the present petition. If such representation is filed, the same shall be decided within shortest time possible i.e. less than five days.
