Petitioner has challenged the order dated 17.5.2017 passed by Civil Judge (Jr.Divn.), Chandigarh, dismissing the application of the petitioner for appointment of handwriting expert.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, it can be appreciated that the execution of Will by Sardari Lal Ohri in favour of plaintiff-respondent No.1 was upheld by the trial Court and the said findings were affirmed by the lower Appellate Court. Regular Second Appeal is statedly pending in the High Court.

In the suit for mandatory injunction filed by the

plaintiff, the petitioner got himself impleaded as party defendant No.2 and thereafter, filed an application for permission to appoint handwriting expert for examination of signatures of Sardari Lal Ohri.

A perusal of the application would show that the permission was sought on the premise that the appointment of handwriting expert is required to examine the signatures of grandfather of the petitioner in various documents attached with the written statement. The pleadings of the application are vague enough to pin point any such document with which comparison was sought to be made. Documents have not been named. Only a vague and indefinite assertion was made in the application without mentioning about admitted documents/ signature of Sardari Lal Ohri.

In view of appreciation done by the trial Court, no case is made out to interfere in this revision petition as the application is totally vague and does not advance the case of the petitioner in any manner.

Accordingly this revision petition is dismissed.
